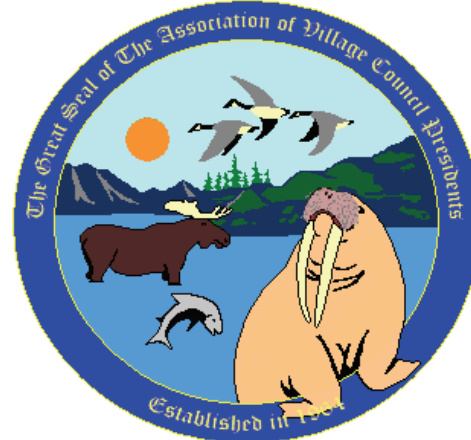

- Are you working?

If you are, you may be eligible for Child Care Services under AVCP.

If you are interested applying for Child Care Services, please call our toll free number 1-800-478-3521 ext. 7456, 7457, 7458, 7459 and we will mail you an application or simply just go to your Tribal office and pick-up a Parent and Provider Child Care application.

- You are enrolled to one of our compact tribe villages
- You are working or going to school full or part time
- Your child(ren) is between the ages of birth through 12 years and is residing with you

Exceptions-Subsidy may be available to age 19 for: 1) Children with special needs whose physical, mental or cognitive abilities are delayed to the extent that they are incapable of taking care of themselves without assistance

- Your family income meets our monthly income eligibility guidelines



Program Purpose

- To increase the availability, affordability, and quality of Child Care
- The program allows parents to engage in educational and employment opportunities.

Child Care Service Area

Parents have the option of choosing which child care service area will best meet their needs, whether its Child's Home, Providers Home, Licensed Family Home or a Child Care Center

Child Care Provider

- Must apply by application, faxed applications will not be approved
- Submit along with application need Tuberculosis Clearance (TB)
- Criminal Background Check
- Must be no less than 18 years of age
